



Simply Baby Bonnet

Knitting Pattern

Nurturing Creativity for Imaginative play



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DESCRIPTION

A very simple, fast and pretty bonnet for your baby doll. Knit flat with a crown decrease to create a pretty shape that hugs, plus crochet ties. Garter stitch front and side bands for a snug fit.

This hat is made to fit dolls with very soft hair that does not bulk up in the back. Up to a 14" head circumference.

REQUIREMENTS

- 5 mm (US size 8) needles
- 1 skein of Drops Loves You (50% alpaca, 40% wool, 10% linen) 100 gr.
- 5 mm crochet hook
- Blunt needle to weave all ends

LEVEL

Intermediate beginner.

TERMINOLOGY

CO. Cast on

BO. Bind off
sts. stitches

CH. chain

P. Purl

K. Knit

K2TOG-TBL. Knit two sts together
through the back loop.

GAUGE

3 sts and 6 rows on 1"x1" in
stockinette.



INSTRUCTIONS

Bonnet

CO 36 sts.

Rows 1 to 6. Knit.

Row 7. K3, P to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 8. Knit.

Repeat last two rows 9 times.

Row 27. K3, P to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 28. BO 3 sts, K3, K2TOG-TBL, (K4, K2TOG) four times, K3.

Row 29. BO 3 sts, Purl.

Row 30. (K3, K2TOG-TBL) five times.

Row 31. Purl.

Row 32. (K2, K2TOG-TBL) five times.

Row 33. Purl.

Row 34. K2TOG all the way, K1.

Cut about 12" inches of yarn tail, and pull through remaining sts,
sew with mattress stitch.

Ties

Join new yarn on front left of bonnet, CH 31. Slip stitch on each
CH all the way back. Secure, cut yarn and weave ends. Repeat on
the other side.
